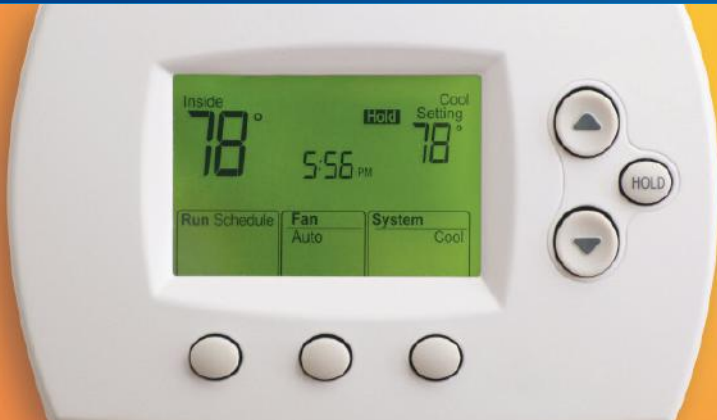

KEEP COOLING AFFORDABLE

The summers in North Carolina keep getting hotter, and higher temps mean higher energy bills. By taking advantage of these energy saving tips you can keep a little extra cash in your wallet and still stay cool in the sweltering summer heat.

Be Mindful of Your Thermostat

– Setting your thermostat to 78 degrees can make for significant energy savings. Every degree cooler than 78 can actually increase your energy use by 3 to 5 percent. Consider installing a programmable thermostat so that your unit will only run when you set it to run. Remember when you go on vacation to set the thermostat for a much higher level or turn it off completely.

Use Vents and Fans to Keep the Air Moving

– Ceiling fans and stationary box fans are a great way to supplement your AC unit's performance. They help circulate the air in your home and aid in removing excess moisture from your skin, making you feel cooler. Also, when you're cooking or showering, turn on the ventilation fans in your kitchen or bathroom. The fans will help draw in excess moisture that your AC unit works hard to remove.

Use Your Microwave – Ovens and stoves increase the overall temperature of your home. When possible, use your microwave. It uses

a third of the energy as your oven and keeps your kitchen from getting too hot.

Check and Replace your Filters

– As always, periodically check and replace the filters on your air conditioning unit. Dirty filters prevent your unit from running at its peak performance and reduce air circulation, trapping harmful allergens and spores in the home.

CHILI-RUBBED PORK CHOPS

Time: 30 min | Yield: 4 Servings

Ingredients:

- 2 large onions
- 1/3 cup New Mexico chili powder
- 1 1/2 tsp Kosher salt
- 1/2 tsp dried oregano
- 1/2 tsp ground cumin
- 1/4 tsp ground cloves
- 2 cloves garlic, smashed
- 8 thin-cut boneless pork chops (about 2 pounds total), trimmed
- Vegetable oil, for brushing
- Spanish rice, for serving (optional)

Instructions:

Roughly chop 1/2 onion and place in a blender with the chili powder, salt, oregano, cumin, cloves and garlic. Puree, adding about 1/3 cup water to make a thick paste. Slice the remaining onions into thin rings and place in a bowl with the chili puree and pork; toss to coat. Grease a large cast-iron skillet or grill pan and place over high heat until almost smoking. Place 4 pork chops in the skillet and surround with half of the onions. Cook until the pork starts to blacken on the outside and is cooked through, about 4 minutes per side. Repeat with the remaining pork chops and onions. Serve with rice, if desired.
